Score 2.0	<p>The student will:</p> <p>Develop and apply skills and strategies to the reading process by developing and applying decoding strategies in fictional text to “problem solve” unknown words when reading grade below grade level <u>independent</u> text. (DRA 18-24, Level J-L)</p> <p>The student exhibits no major errors or gaps in the simpler details and processes.</p>
	1.5 Partial understanding of the 2.0 content with major errors or gaps in 3.0 content.
Score 1.0	With help, a partial understanding of the 2.0 content and some of the 3.0 content. (DRA 16 and below/Level I and below)
	0.5 With help, a partial understand of the 2.0 content and none of the 3.0 content.
Score 0.0	Even with help, no understanding or skill demonstrated.
