GENERAL INFORMATION

Pell Grant

- Awarded by U.S. Department of Education
- For undergraduates who do not have a bachelor's degree
- Based on financial need
- Applies to programs at least 600 clock-hours in length

A+

- Awarded by Department of Elementary & Secondary Education
- Funds for tuition
- Must meet state guidelines while in high school

Displaced Homemaker Waiver Program

- Federally funded – awarded by LCTC
- Award amount based on career goals, needs and program
- Recipients must be enrolled in approved career and technical programs

Veteran's Assistance

- Contact local VA counselor
- Recipients must be enrolled in approved career and technical programs

Vocational Rehabilitation

- Contact local Vocational Rehabilitation office
- Recipients must be enrolled in approved career and technical programs

Workforce Investment Act

- Contact local WIA program operator for your home county
- Recipients must fall below specified income guidelines and/or meet other barriers to employment

Rural Missouri

- Contact headquarters in Jefferson City
- Recipients must fall below specified income guidelines
- Funds for tuition and training-related support services
