We will be working on collecting facts and writing informational booklets about their favorite animals. Students will illustrate their booklets. In math, the class will continue working on addition and subtraction problems, using number bonds to help them understand these operations. They will also be continuing to work with story problems.

Mrs. Schwab's Class



In Mrs. Schwab's class we will be reading our first chapter book as a class. We will compare and contrast the characters in the story. We will follow their development throughout the book. We will also be focusing on "time and money". Our goals: telling time to five minutes and counting coins to one dollar.

Mrs. Chesen's Class



Students in Mrs. Chesen's room continue to discuss their leadership skills and how they are developing these skills in the school and home setting. They share how they have been a leader and which of the SEVEN HABITS they are working on.

Students have also been working on reading and math skills. In reading they are sharing the story of Charlotte's Web. They are working on character traits, word meaning and story sequence. They are also explaining how a character's actions can change the course of a story. In math they are working on 2-3 step problems involving addition, subtraction, and multiplication. They are also rounding to the nearest tens and hundreds.
